15 mm Eyes 18 mm nosk

Materials: 4-ply yarn- 6ozs. Gold, small amounts tan and black; sport yarn- 1 oz. red, small amount green; one ½" white button; two 12-mm animal eyes; polyester fiberfill; E and G hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge.

Gauge: With E hook, 5 sc= 1"; 5 sc rows= 1". With G hook, 4sc rows= 1"; 4 sc rows = 1".

Finished size: 15" tall.

Note: Do not join rnds unless otherwise stated. Mark first st of each rnd.

Head:

I like to make the ears first, so they are ready to work

Rnd1: With G hook and tan, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

Rnd2: 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)

Rnd 4: Sc in each st around

Rnd 5: (sc in each of next sts, 2 sc in next st) around (24)

Rnd 6-8: Sc in each st around. At end of rnd 8, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off

Rnd 9: Join gold with se in first st of rnd 8, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 16 sts, sc in next 4 (40). Mark last st for center bottom of

chin.

Rnd 10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 4 sts (2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts) 8 times, sc in next 4 sts (48).

Rnds 12-17: Sc in each st around. Local and 13 of 14

Rnd 18: Sc in next 12 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) 5 times, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts (54)

Rnds 19-20: Sc in each st around

Rnd 21: (Sc in next 7 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (48)

Rnd 22: (Sc in next 6 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (42)

Rnd 23: (Sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (36). Stuff.

Rnd 24: (sc in next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (30)

Rnd 25: (Sc in each of next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (24)

Rnd 26: (Sc in each of next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (18)

Rnd 27: (Sc in next st, sc next sts tog) around (12). Leaving 12" for sewing, fasten off. Stuff, sew opening closed. Place eyes between rnds 10 and 11, 2 1/4" apart. With black, embroider nose with satin stitch, mouth with straight stitch.

Ear:

Rnd 1: With G hook and gold, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6).

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each st around (12).

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around

Rnd 4: (Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)

(3) Rnd 5-7: Sc in each st around

Rnd 8: (Sc next 2 sts tog) around (9).

Row 9: Flatten ear; working through both thicknesses, sc in each st across (5). Leaving 12" for sewing, fasten off. Sew to rnd of 18 of head, 2 1/4" apart.

Body: Start with long tout (well asich attach head)

Rnd 1: With G hook and gold, ch 24, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around (24).

Rnd 2: (Sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around (30).

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) around (36)

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) around (42).

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: Sc in each of next 3 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts) 5 times, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next sts (48).

Rnd 8: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: (Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) 6 times (54).

Rnd 10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 4 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts) 5 times, 2 sc in Rnds 12-20: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 21: (Sc in next 8 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (54).

Rnd 22: (Sc in next 7 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (48).

Rnd 23: (Sc in next 6 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (42).

Rnd 24: For first leg: Sl st in first st, ch 3, skip next 20 sts, sl st in next st, ch1, sc in same st, sc in each st around to ch 3, sc in each of next 3 ch (24). 5 Paris For "Shorts"

6-3-6 1 Stripe

Last & For shortslear

Rnds 25-36: Sc in each st around. change to Votat color

Rnd 37: Mark center front of leg, sc in each st around with 2 sc in each of 7 center front sts (31).

Rnd 38: Sc in each st around with 2 sc in each of 4 center front sts (35).

Rnds 39-42: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 43: (Sc in next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (30).

Rnd 44: (Sc in each of next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (24).

Rnd 45: (Sc in each of next 2 sts, sc next 2 sts tog) around (18). Stuff.

Rnd 46: (Sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) around (12). Leaving 12" for sewing, fasten off. Sew seam lengthwise.

Rnd 24: For 2nd leg, join gold with sc in 8th st of rnd 23, sc in each st and each ch around (24).

Rnds 25-46: Repeat rnds 25-46 of first leg. Stuff Body, sew to head.

Arm (make 2):

Rnd 1: With G hook and gold, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6).

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around (18)

A CONSTRAINT Rnds 4-21: Sc in each st around. Stuff. Rnd 22: Now working in rows, se in next 9 sts, sl st in next st leaving last 8 sts-unworked, turn (9). Se 2 log avound

Rnd 23; Skip sl st, sc in next 9 sts, sl st in next st on rnd 21, turn (9). Rnd 24: Now working in rnds, skip sl st, (sc next 2 sts tog) 4 times, sc next sc and sl st tog, (sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with sl st in first sc (9). Leaving 12" for sewing, fasten off. Stuff. Sew to side of body on rnds 5-9.

(I don't do This) Vest:

NOTE: First sc is worked in same st as ch 1.

Front: (Make 2)

Row 1: With E hook and red, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn (4).

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn

Row 7: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn (5).

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, 2sc in last st, turn (6).

Row 9: Repeat row 7 (7).

Row 10: Repeat row 2.

Rows 11-16: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn (9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19). Win 12 13 1 14 1 15 1 15 1

Row 17-20: Repeat row 2.

Row 21: Ch 1 sc in first sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Back:

Row 1: With E hook and red, ch 36, sc in 2nd ch, from hook, sc in each ch across, turn (35).

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Scarf = 70 ch - Sc
