Volunteer Job Descriptions

Tutor

Tutors will meet with children either at our Central Coast headquarters in Salinas, in their or the youth's home, or virtually via Zoom. The tutor can identify which subjects they are qualified to assist with.

Requirements: Must be 18 years or older and must have a background check.

Interested volunteers will:

- 1. Complete an application and provide references
- 2. Meet with a program director for a brief interview
- 3. Complete a Live Scan fingerprint background check (\$25.00 fee)

Community Liaison

Under the guidance and supervision of the Development Department, the Community Liaison will provide support in Seneca's outreach efforts by attending community events as assigned.

Examples of duties:

- Become familiar with what Seneca does/attend orientation meeting
- Set up display and material at events
- Provide to the community at various locations information on Seneca's programs and services including foster care, relative caregiver support and our children's mental health programs.
